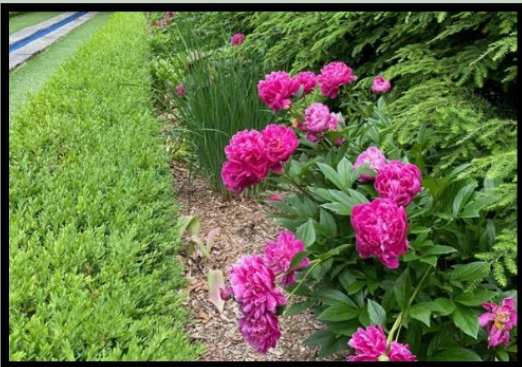

## *Clematis*

- *Clematis x jackmanii*, 'Jackmanii' Clematis
- Found at the historic Turnaround Wall, at the ADA Parking near the mansion
- Clematis vines need a trellis or other support on which to grow on.
- thus, this is what Cornelia did, the restoration of the cedar trellis & replanting the same variety of Clematis in the pockets of the wall soften the structure, as desired in the 1930's.



## *Peony*

- *Paeonia dentate* 'Karl Rosenfield', Karl Rosenfield' Peony
- Featured in the Long Garden, based on designs by Cornelia Pinchot & Harriett K. Kaupp.
- These red double blooms are spectacularly displayed on sturdy, erect stems emerging from beautiful lush, green foliage on a rounded form.



## *Oriental Poppy*

- *Papaver orientale* 'Beauty of Livermere', 'Beauty of Livermere' Oriental Poppy
- These bright orange stunners are features in the Long Garden.
- The petals are thin and translucent, glowing beautifully in sunlight, and resemble delicate crepe paper.
- During the Long Garden restoration, the Poppies were replanted to show the beauty of the 1920's and 1930's gardens at Grey Towers.
