Shasta Daisy

- *Leucanthemum x superbum* 'Becky',
- 'Becky' Shasta Daisy
- This midsummer bloom can be found in the Long Garden.
- They are planted in clumps, as designed by Cornelia Pinchot
- This planting was recreated during the Long Garden restoration, completed in 2018.



Tiger Lily

- *Hemerocallis fulva*, Tiger Lily or Ditch Lily
- Cornelia was a fan of all lilies and featured many in her gardens, both lilies and day lilies.
- These orange beauties can be found up at the Pool Terrace and the walkway near the Marble Court.



Water Lilies

- Nymphaeaceae, Water Lilies
- These freshwater flowering plants are a charming garden plant because of their excellent beauty and the pleasure they bring to our ponds.
- Cornelia featured lilies like these as well as goldfish in her Moat
- The Moat was one of the last landscape features created by Cornelia.
