Weeping Forsythia

- *Forsythia suspensa var sieboldii*
- This historic cascading shrub planted by Cornelia Pinchot in the original planting pockets built into the retaining wall of the East Terrace
- These bright yellow beauties cascade into the moat below, creating a waterfall effect



Star Magnolia

- *Magnolia stellata*
- This attractive white flowering specimen tree glows white against the backdrop of the service wing part of the mansion.
- This accent plant is a replacement for the original planted by Cornelia Pinchot years ago



Daffodil

- *Narcissus*
- The ten varieties featured on the Allee are:
*JETFIRE *FEBRUARY GOLD *CARLTON
*DUTCHMASTER *GOLDEN HARVEST * HAWERA
*MT HOOD *THALIA *PHEASANT EYE
*SEMPRE AVANTI
- These heirloom bulbs lovingly planted, by the Volunteer Horticulture Team, over 14 years ago took 3 years of fall plantings to create this eye catching display.
- Daffodils are among the happiest flowers to grace our gardens with bright yellows and whites
- The staggered bloom times create a longer lasting display as one experiences the Historic Allee.
